## **Coastal Commission**

- Established by voter initiative in 1972 and made permanent by the Legislature through adoption of the California Coastal Act of 1976.
- Plans and regulates the use of land and water in the coastal zone including (among others)
  - construction of buildings,
  - divisions of land, and
  - activities that change the intensity of use of land or public access to coastal waters
- The Commission is an independent, quasi-judicial state agency
- County Supervisor Greg Cox is our representative; Escondido Councilwoman Olga Diaz is alternate.



## San Diego County

- Created in 1850 as one of California's original 27 counties
- Originally included much of the Colorado and Mojave deserts, including all of Imperial County and much of San Bernardino and Riverside counties
- First Board of Supervisors meeting 1853
  - Five supervisors, each representing a district
  - May serve no more than two 4-year terms
  - Hire County Executive, set priorities, oversee administration
